



## 1st Call for Papers

International scientific-practical conference  
**"Russia and Korea in the Modern Information Space",**  
will be held on **October 1-2, 2022** in **Irkutsk** at **Irkutsk State University**

The conference is organized by Center for Korean Studies of Irkutsk State University and Korea Foundation.

A paper with any of the following or related subjects would be appropriate for presentation: **history of Russian-Korean relations, socio-economic, legal and cultural aspects of modern Russian-Korean relations as well as their reflection in the information space of Russia and abroad.**

**Eligible Applicants:** Researchers from Russian and overseas universities and academic institutions, experts in the field of Korean studies and related fields working in state and private organizations.

**Working languages:** Organizing Committee decided to accept presentations and papers in Russian and English languages.

**Applicants** are invited to submit the following information by e-mail to [ivanov\\_kv@isu.ru](mailto:ivanov_kv@isu.ru):

- 1) full name, full name of the institution or organization, city;
- 2) position;
- 2) academic degree / rank (if any);
- 3) contact info (e-mail and telephone);
- 4) paper title and abstract (200-300 words) in print-ready format, 5-6 keywords.

The **deadline** for applications is **June 6, 2022**. We will contact all applicants regarding the acceptance of their application by **June 15, 2022**.

The full paper should be sent to the organizers no later than **July 20, 2022**. All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) with DOI assignment. The organizing committee is planning to hold in-person conference, with individual remote participation via video conferencing.

Full papers submission requirements: no more than 10 000 characters with spaces; line spacing - 1 (single); Times New Roman font; font size - 14; text must be both left and right justified with the margins (left margin - 25 mm, right margin - 20 mm, top margin - 20 mm, bottom margin - 20 mm); the text must be automatically hyphenated, manual hyphenation is unacceptable.

Organizing Committee provides hotel accommodation and meals during the conference, as well as partial reimbursement of travel expenses (depending on the number of participants and cost of travel) to participants from other cities and countries whose papers will be included in the conference program.

Due to the uncertainty of the situation with international air traffic, **foreign participants** are invited to take part in the conference via videoconferencing.

Conference program, accommodation details, as well as other additional information on the conference will be posted in the **2nd Call for Papers**.

We kindly ask all recipients of this announcement letter to inform their colleagues who are interested in the subject of the conference about it.
